

The landscape of Reotahi is being threatened by invasive weeds and perhaps your backyard too? This March, Weed Action Whangarei Heads will be taking action in the community with **TWO** events along the coastal walkway and we hope you can join us.



**Event One: Weed Info Walk - Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> March 5.30pm – 7.30pm**

Take an easy walk with Weed Action to learn how to control 12 of the worst environmental weeds that threatened to change the landscape of our community – the ‘Dirtiest Dozen’. Learn what they look like, why they’re a threat and what we stand to lose if we don’t take action!

Where: Reotahi Coastal Walkway. Meeting at the car park at the end of Beach Rd, Reotahi.

Details: Bring the family and some comfortable walking shoes. We will be walking from the carpark end towards Little Munro Bay for approx. 1km before turning around and walking back. Sunset will be around 7.45pm.

**Event Two: Working Bee - Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 9.00am – 11.30am**

So, you want to take action? Great! You will be fully briefed in the morning on the weeds we will be targeting for control and how to do so safely.

Where: Reotahi Coastal Walkway. Meeting at the car park at the end of Beach Rd, Reotahi.

Provided: All personal protective equipment ie safety glasses, gloves & overalls. Herbicide and tools ie 500ml trigger sprayers, handsaws & drills. Morning tea.

What to bring: Appropriate footwear (boots are recommended). Sunblock & water. Garden loppers (if available).
